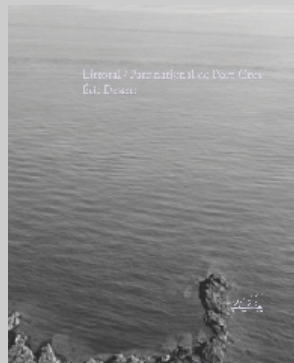


Littoral / Parc national de Port-Cros
