



## Ivresse de l'œil Jacques Borgetto

Travelling around the world, Jacques Borgetto observes the signs and shapes that reality takes pleasure in offering him, reproducing it in a mosaic of cut-mounted images that enables him to reveal unexpected relations...

... between a small black girl in a white dress carrying a bouquet of flowers and the ocean rolling on the rocks, between beach games and a country chapel, between a TV antenna and a bird cage, between a mother protecting her child under an umbrella and the square in a nameless town photographed from behind a glass.

Trading the weight of the 4x5 large-format camera in favour of the lightness of the cellphone, switching technical precision for the freedom of action in the little visual box in his pocket, this globe-trotting photographer places his stakes on the instantaneous quality of what suddenly appears, rather than the device that composes the beautiful image.
