


Les enfantillages pittoresques Laurent Millet

In his work as a photographer and artist, Laurent Millet chapters consists of an imaginary encyclopedia, populated by objects that built in natural settings or in his workshop. His assemblages are hybrids of traditional objects, scientific, architectural, as well as works by artists he likes the work

What's this? Sculpture? Drawing? DIY? On installation? The artist sets up "poetic machinery" he then photographs and the final image comes justify all the steps that preceded it.
