In 2021 and 2022, Anne Rearick spent a few months in Le Perche region, immersing herself among the residents, their aninch radiacer landscapes. Her photography depicts the daily experience of the worlds she delves into, celebrating them with delicacy. Released "Freed from any globalizing project, she allows each person to express themselves in turn, with gazes, poses, gestures, and released the reconnects with this deeply humanistic photography that never looks inward, that doesn't seek ego or identity but rather the other, their equal."
