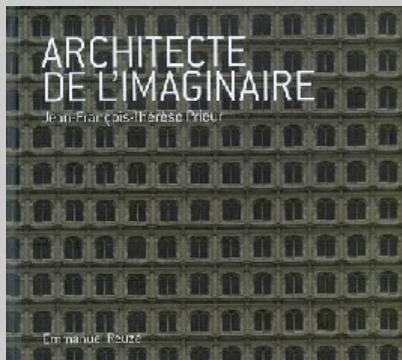


# Architecte de l'imaginaire
