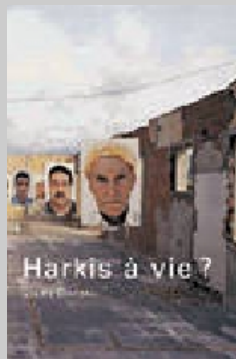


# Harkis à vie ?
